

RoboParade Traffic rules (Qualifying Test)

- 1. Robot must be fully autonomous with an official rear bumper
- 2. Robot must have a reliable program to follow a black line on a bright surface.
- 3. Robot must have the ability to detect a vehicle in front of it and stop; then automatically re-start when the vehicle in front has cleared.
- 4. Robot must display current speed and the speed must be greater than 7cm / sec and less than or equal to 17 cm / sec
- 5. Length of a unit must be less than 35cm
- 6. Team must pass a written exam about speed calculation
