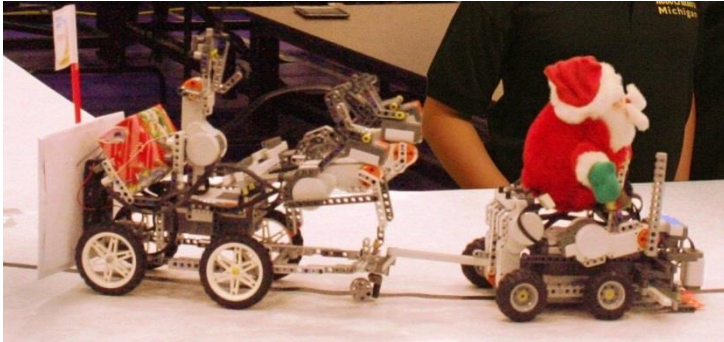


# ROBOParade Camp for Rookie Teams
