Future Plans: The desire to serve humanity and save lives has propelled my choice of future ambition.


Growing up in an environment like Africa whereby people are been deprived of good health facilities and also health care contributed to the profession I have chosen.

I would be glad enough if I could study in your amiable country to have sound education, access to good facilities and laboratory, diversities in culture and learn from best practitioners.




