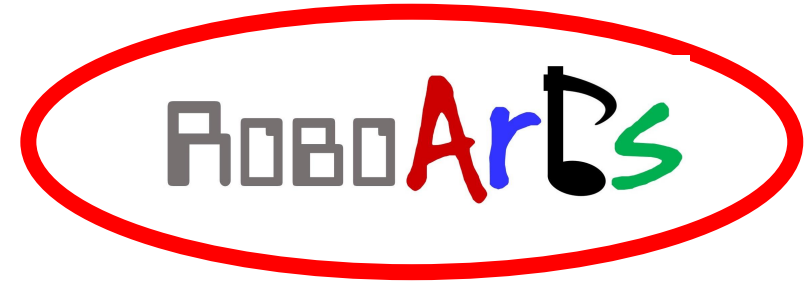

Judging Process and Determining Winners

- Teams are *required* to provide a video link (**as well as source code files**) on the Robofest registration system. Judges will review before the competition
- Code Inspector(s) will recommend points for programming
- Judges are selected by Lawrence Tech Robofest office. Bios will be available
- Host gives the microphone (unmute) to each team
- Each team has 4 minutes to present & demo robot(s)

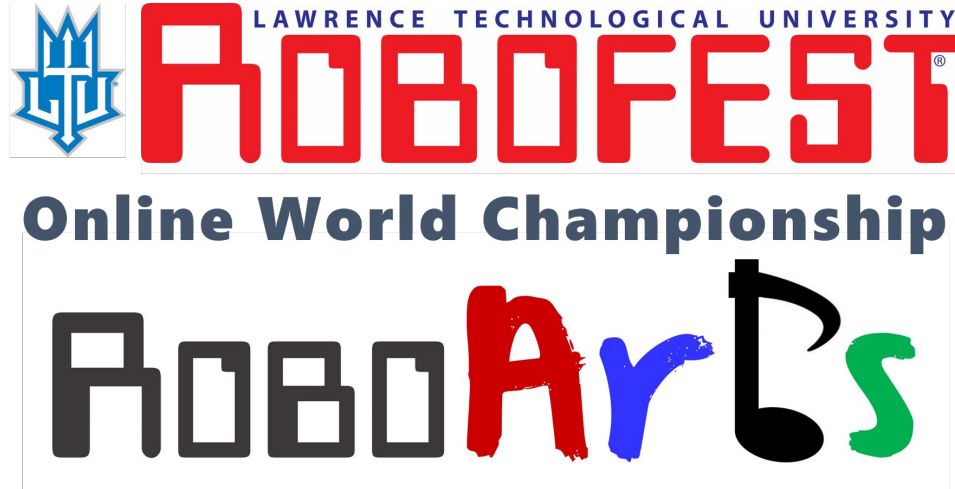
Judging Process and Determining Winners

- Judges will ask questions *after the presentation for 2 minutes*
- Teams must use English for all communications. Judge's question may be translated at local only when teams did not understand. However, teams must answer directly in English.
- Judges may ask additional questions by email to teams within 24 hours after the competition. Teams must answer within 24 hours
