LHJ is required to PRINT THIS CHECKLIST and check off each item before logging in to the Online Event on event day. During Check-in, show this completed and signed sheet to the Site Host.

 - Prepare: pencil, clipboard, measuring tape (at least 100 cm), tripod (optional)

Prior to Check-In on Event Day:

- Confirm Team is ready to present a 1-minute introduction of the team and the robot when called upon during opening
- Confirm LHJ is ready to present a brief introduction when called upon during opening
- Confirm Recording Judge has the recording device with battery and sufficient memory
- Confirm Coach has printed team sign and has it ready to show
- ☐ Confirm Coach has received Consent Form (online or hard copy) for each participant
- Check Robot Size w/l maximum 50x50 cm including expansion
- ☐ Check Robot has "Front" label
- ☐ Inspect Robot for any illegal materials (see section 8 of rules)
- Assemble Judges and Team (with robot) to prepare for Event Check-in

Sr StackRolls - Rules for ROWC

- Unknown Tasks and Factors (Robot start location and any special unknowns), are unveiled 30 minutes prior to impounding robots for each round
- After impounding, the c, d, and e dimensions are announced and Judges will set the rolls on the field
- Winners will be decided by the average results from the 2 rounds
